Contestants are judged based on a set of criteria that measure their demonstration of intellectual thinking and positive expression in an original written and oral presentation of the annual theme. College scholarships are awarded to the contestants with the highest scores. The Oratorical Contest is held annually during the National Baptist Congress of Christian Education Annual Session.

Theme: “Building a Solid Life with the Savior”

Scripture: I Corinthians 3:9

The contest shall be held in the following 4 categories:

- **Graduating high School Seniors** (12th grade) 600-800 words -*The speech must be memorized.*
- **High School** (9th to 11th grade) 600-800 words -*The speech must be memorized.*
- **Middle School** (6th to 8th grade) 500-700 words- Students are encouraged to memorize, but may read from typewritten speech.
- **Elementary School** (2nd to 5th grade) 400-600 words - Students are encouraged to memorize, but may read from typewritten speech.

These requirements are based on the rules of the National Baptist Oratorical Contest. The wording is changed to fit the OBGC.

REQUIREMENTS:

1. **A Graduating High School contestant** must be currently enrolled in his/her senior year and graduate before September, 2012.
2. Contestants are expected to prepare their own paper. Papers must be typewritten and double-spaced. (See word-count above.)
3. Papers must be prepared in triplicate. Submit one original and two copies to: Oratorical Contest, Zion Hill Missionary Baptist Church, 1900 Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Way, Dayton, Ohio 45417, Attention: Sis. Phyllis Stewart by Wednesday, April 25.
4. There will be no sermonettes.
5. There will be no introduction reference to protocol by the Contestant. He/she will stand, state the topic and begin his/her oration.
6. Upon violation of rules, contestant(s) will be disqualified.
7. **Dress Code: Men-Suit coats with ties; Ladies-Dress or suit with hosiery.**
8. The oration will be judged on the quality of the composition, subject matter, content, originality, delivery, vocal control, enunciation, pronunciation, stage decorum (body language, gestures) and mastery of material.
9. The decision of the judges will be final.
