

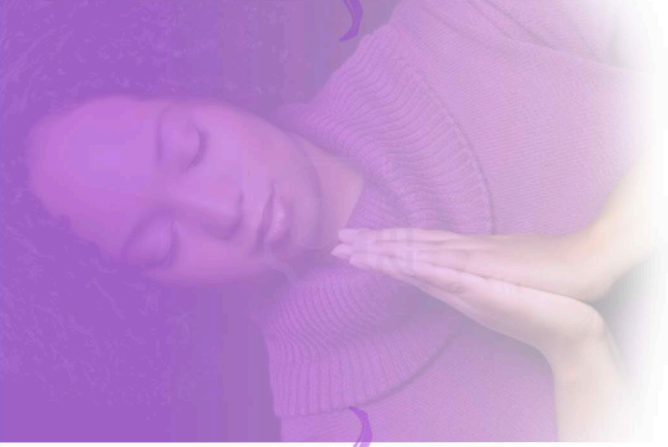

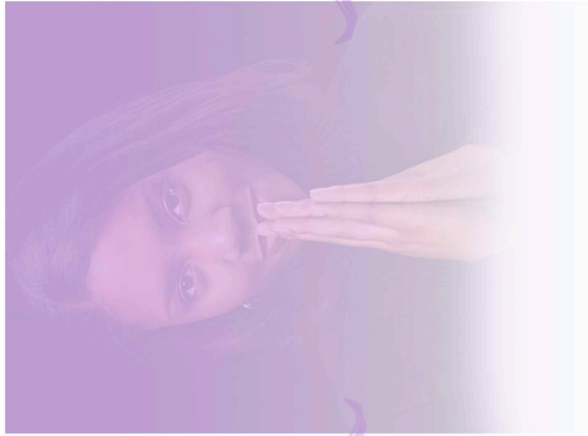

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Greetings and Blessing,

It is with great joy that we write this letter on behalf of the Youth and Young Adult Auxiliary (YYA) of The Ohio Baptist General Convention.
