The doctrine of Christ and the gospel of Grace is non-negotiable. Christian people who love the Lord, must accept the responsibility for regaining our people who have lost their place Be vigorously active and aggressive in support of a cause, that cause being Saving Souls and as one Moderator stated **WIN the LOST at ANY COST "By Any Means Necessary"** (2 Peter 3:9) *The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.*

7. Are you prepared for evangelism and discipleship? Be A Soldier for the Lord. "Women on the Battlefield for the Lord, Serving with a Heart like Jesus."

Jesus expectations for his followers are clear in Luke 6:40 "The disciple is not above his master: but every one that is perfect shall be as his master. Luke 9:23 "And he said to them all, If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow me. Being a disciple of Jesus requires a determined choice to follow him in the midst of heard teachings (Reference John 6:60-66).

Paul said in 1 Corinthians 9:22 "*To the weak became I as weak*, that I might gain the weak: I am made all things to all men, that I might by all means save some." Paul limits his personal freedom in order to win more people to faith in Christ. He has become as a Jew and law follower to even some of them. He has become as one who is outside of the law, a Gentile, to win some of them.
